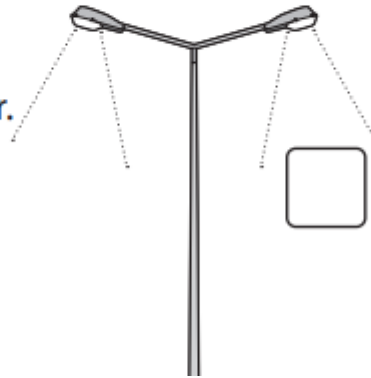
- Measure the height of your family members

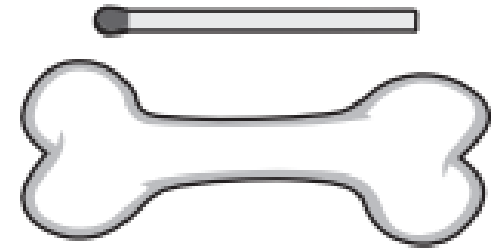
2 Which is taller?
