
Life cycle of a butterfly template:

Go to 'Phonics Pop': <https://www.ictgames.com/phonicsPop/index.html>

Click 'Set 7: y, z, zz, qu'. Support your child to play the game by identifying the sounds.

Get children to point and say sounds on the sound sheet that was sent home. These are all of Phase 2 sounds and some of phase 3 (up to igh). You can also find these in the 'Phonics - Family Learning' document and as an attachment to the email sent.

Encourage children to read and spell these phase 3 words.

chain	teeth	thicker
faith	sheep	lightning

Encourage your child to read and write these phase 3 phrases:

fish and chips on a dish

sixteen trees

the light of the night

digging in the pot
