3. Think about a film you watched recently. How did the main characters solve a problem that they had?

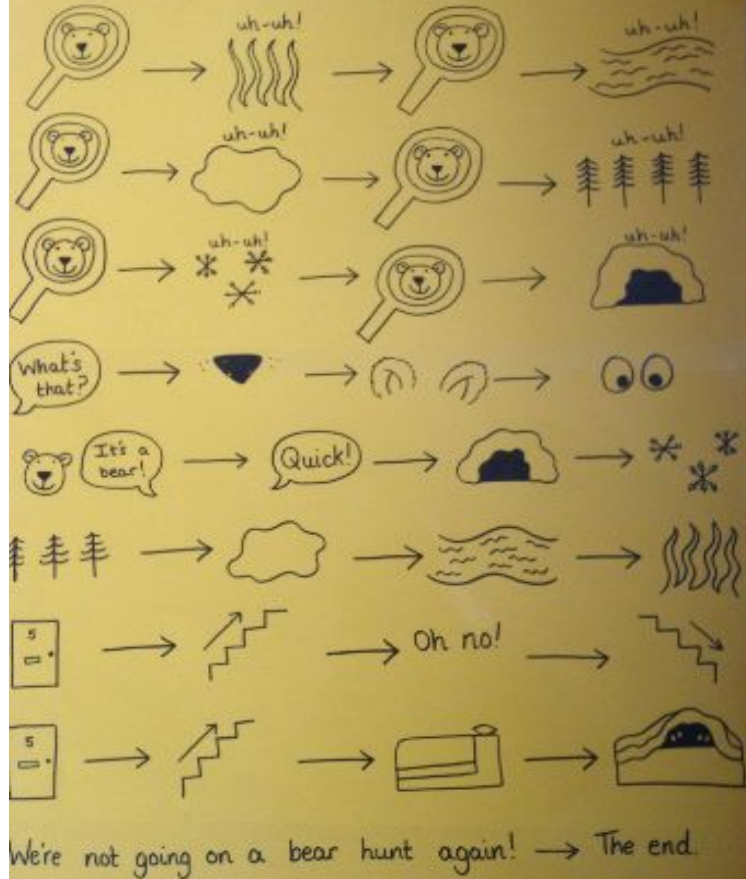
