



### Kimberley's Phonics group

Support your child to read the 'I can spot...' comic, focussed on 'sh, ch, th, ng' sounds.

Get children to point and say sounds on the sound sheet that was sent home. These are all of Phase 2 sounds and some of phase 3 (up to igh). You can also find these in the 'Phonics - Family Learning' document and as an attachment to the email sent.

Encourage your child to read these phase 3 sentences:

They can get fish and chips, too.

Then we can all run to the shop.

Kevin has a wigwam in the shed.

Alex, Jon and Jeevan visit him.

Watch the 'j' sound video. Support children in writing the 'j' sound in pre-cursive handwriting:
