Draw a picture of the building or think of some questions for Monica and her dogs. You can ask an adult to help you write them down.



If the above link does not work, go to <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/> and login. Click 'Resources', 'Phase 3' and scroll down to the game 'Make a Match, Phase 3 (week 5)'.

Get children to point and say sounds on the sound sheet that was sent home. These are all of Phase 2 sounds and some of phase 3 (up to igh). You can also find these in the 'Phonics - Family Learning' document and as an attachment to the email sent.

Encourage children to read and answer the phase 3 questions with yes/no.

Has a pot of jam got a lid?	Can a taxi hop?
Can a van go up a hill?	Has a cat got a web?

Children can then practice writing the 'm' sound in pre-cursive writing:

Encourage children to make their own words in pre-cursive handwriting, which include the 'm' sound. For example: Meg, my, mount, farm. Have a go at saying and writing animal names starting with 'm' too.
