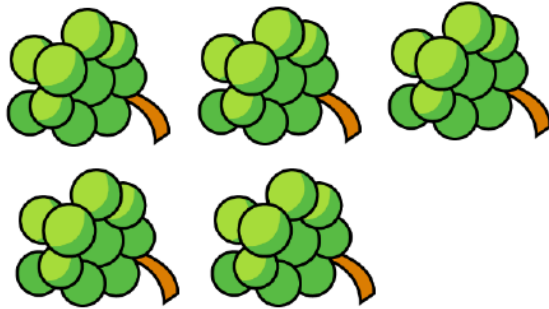

PROPHET MUHAMMAD (PEACE BE UPON HIM)

Prophet Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) is the final Prophet and messenger of Allah. Previous Prophets and messengers were sent to their own community, but Prophet Muhammad was extra special because he was chosen to teach all of mankind!

His teachings were narrated and written down by different people in the past. These sayings of the Prophet are called Hadith.

Prophet Muhammad said in one of these Hadith:

"Love Allah for what He nourishes you with of His Blessings, love me due to the love of Allah, and love the people of my house due to love of me."

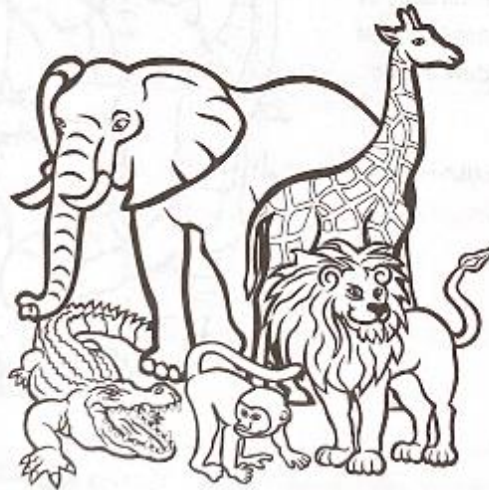

PROPHET MUHAMMAD (PEACE BE UPON HIM) WAS COMPASSIONATE

Prophet Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) showed compassion to all those around him; family, friends, orphans, and strangers. He also treated the environment and animals with respect and mercy. He taught his followers that because animals were part of God's creation they should be treated with dignity and love. There are many hadith teaching us to care for animals. For example Prophet Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) said, 'Fear God in your treatment of animals.' (Abu Dawood)

Let's Learn About It

Laylat al-Qadr is also known as the Night of Power. It is a very special night during the month of Ramadan because Allah multiplies rewards for good deeds and forgives people who make a special dua!

There is no fixed date for Laylat Al-Qadr so Muslims work extra hard during the last third of Ramadan. It is said to occur on one of the odd-numbered nights during the last 10 days of Ramadan. This means it can be the 21st, 23rd, 25th, 27th or the 29th. But just in case there was a mistake on the moon sighting, we are advised to spread our energy and worship out across all the 10 nights.
