I was born in 1961 in Honolulu, Hawaii to my parents Ann and Barack.

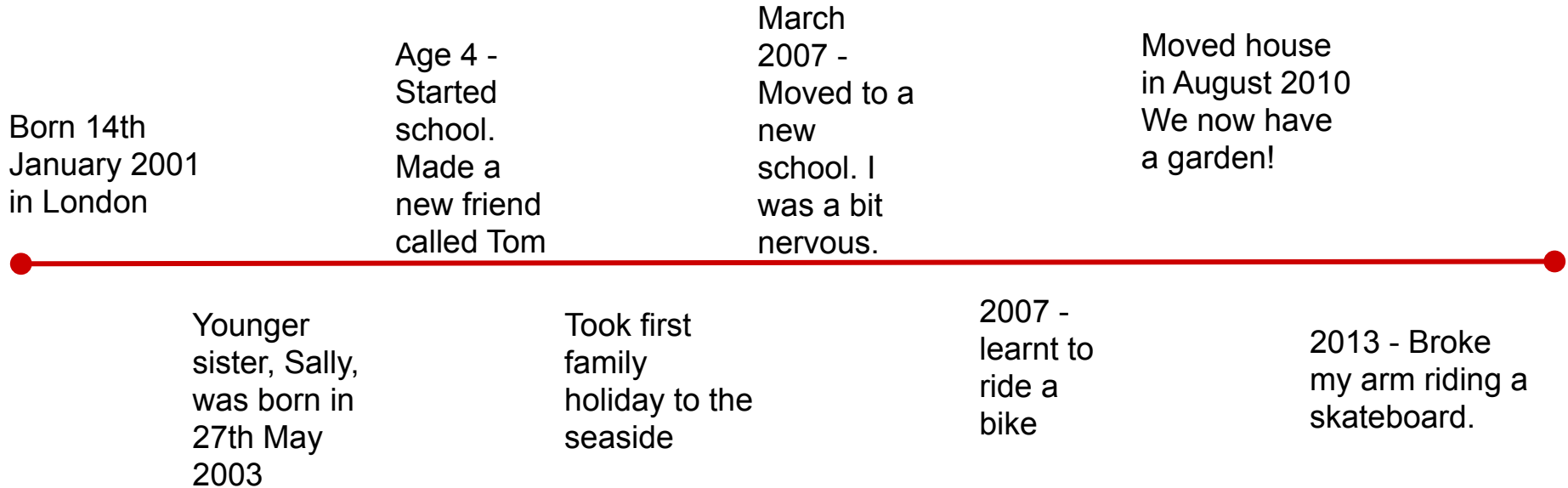
