





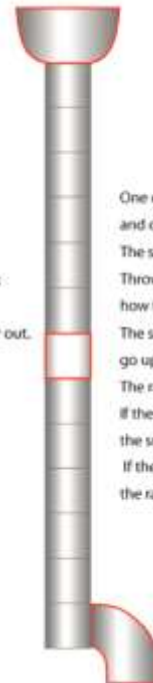
Incy Wincey Maths

Climbing up again.

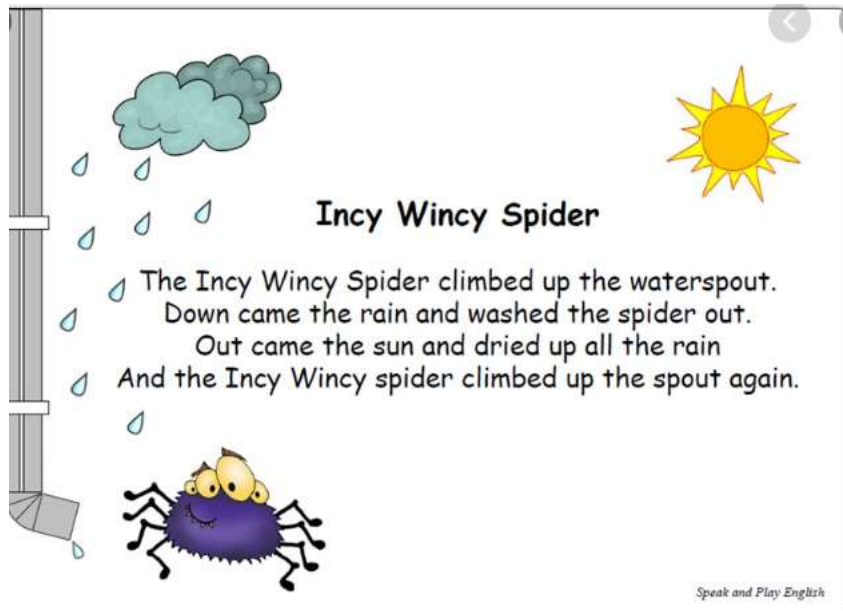


One of you is the sunshine

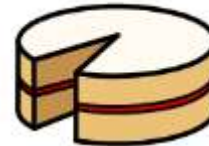
