











## Nursery homeworking tasks

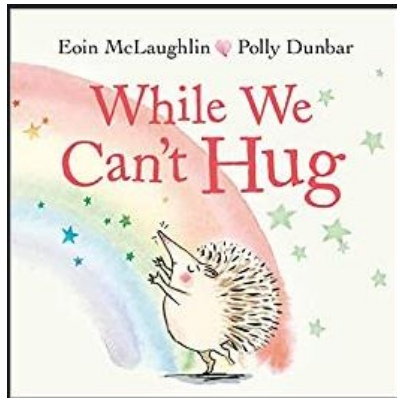

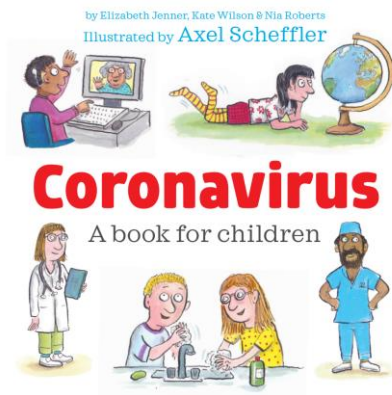

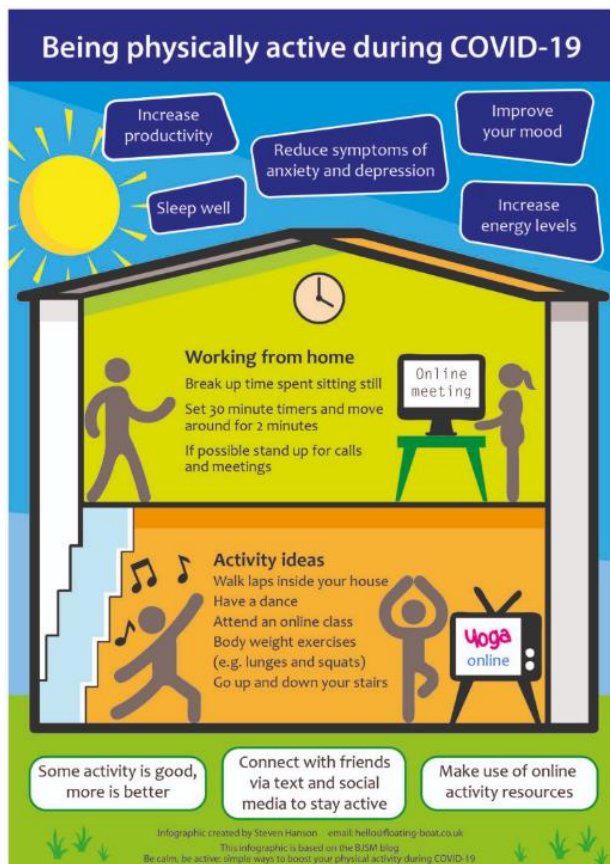
