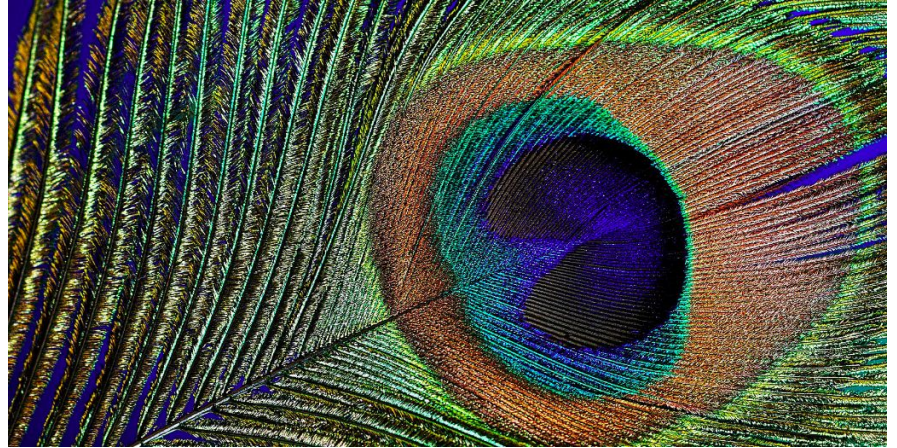


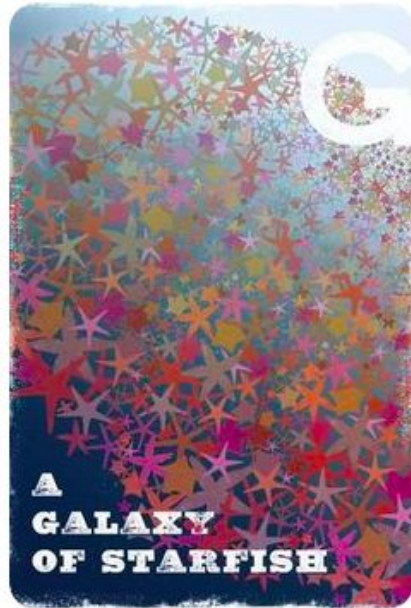
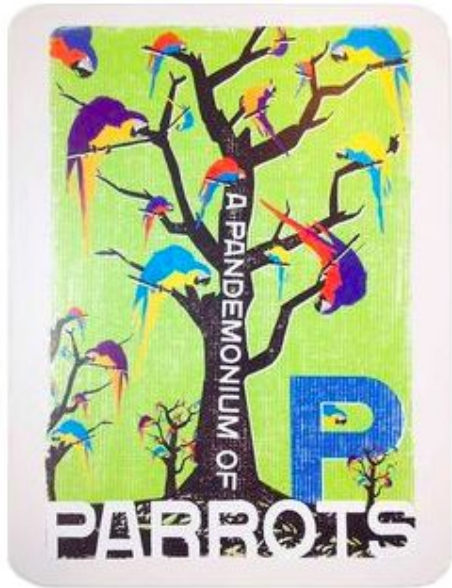
# Creative Writing

The extreme design you will learn about is **The Bloodhound Supersonic Car**.



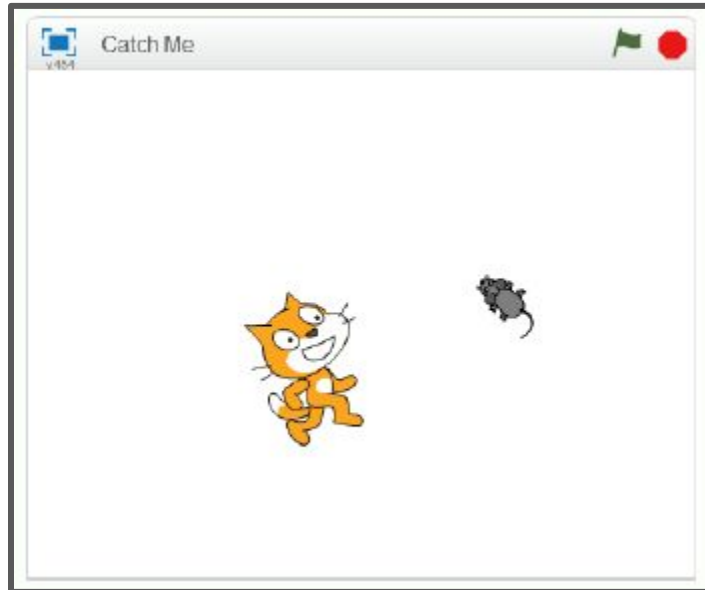
Its inventors are hoping it will travel at 1,000 miles per hour -that is 1 mile in 3.5 seconds!! which would make it the fastest car in the world.
