Today you will be making some number cards and exploring numbers.

There are also books to read, Phonics games and some yoga – have fun!

You will need:

Paper

Felt tips

String

Pegs



Step 1




Make your number cards from 0 to 10.
Write the numbers carefully and don't forget to add your coloured dots.

You can choose different numbers if you like, such as 0 to 20 or 11 to 20.

You may even want to make bigger numbers, it's up to you! ☺

Step 2




Put your number cards in order from smallest to largest.

Practice counting forwards.

Practice counting backwards.

You can even order your number cards from largest to smallest, it's up to you! ☺


Step 3



Ask someone at home to mix your number cards up.

Can you put them back in the right order?

Step 4



Ask someone at home to take some of your number cards away.

What are the missing numbers?

Find the missing numbers and decide where they need to go.

Step 5



Ask someone at home to help you put up a washing line. You could use your dining table legs.

Use the pegs to put up your number cards in order.

Count forwards and backwards.

Step 6



Ask someone at home to mix up all of the number cards on your washing line.

Can you put them back in the right order?
