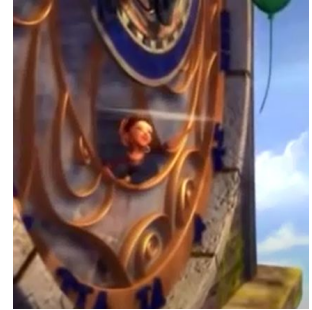

Improving Our Environment.




