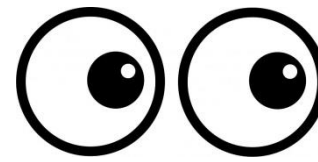

*A digger has to clear the track at the airport.
A road-gritter puts down sand to keep the road clear.*

It rains a lot in winter. We get hail storms in winter if the rain freezes.
