Using these logon details go to Phonics Play.

Click on Tricky Word Trucks. Support your child by listening to them say the word on the screen. You can give them a tick when they get it right. If needed, support them in their reading of the words. Please make sure that you click Phase 3, then 'Phase 3 Tricky Words'. If your child is ready, you can click on the more challenging 'Phase 3 All HFW'.

For the above link to work you **must** be logged in

If the above link does not work, go to <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/> and login. Click 'Resources', 'Phase 3' and scroll down to the game 'Tricky Word Trucks'.

Get children to point and say sounds on the sound sheet that was sent home. These are all of Phase 2 sounds and some of phase 3 (up to igh). You can also find these in the 'Phonics - Family Learning' document and as an attachment to the email sent.

Encourage children to read and spell these phase 3 words.

sail	seem	right
main	meet	sight
tail	week	fight

Re-watch the 'f' sound video from last time. Support children in writing the 'ff' sound in pre-cursive handwriting:

Encourage children to make their own words in pre-cursive handwriting, which include the 'ff' sound. For example: cliff, huff, puff, sniff, whiff, fluff, stuff, staff.
