Create your own comic strip about a superhero or someone who saves the day.

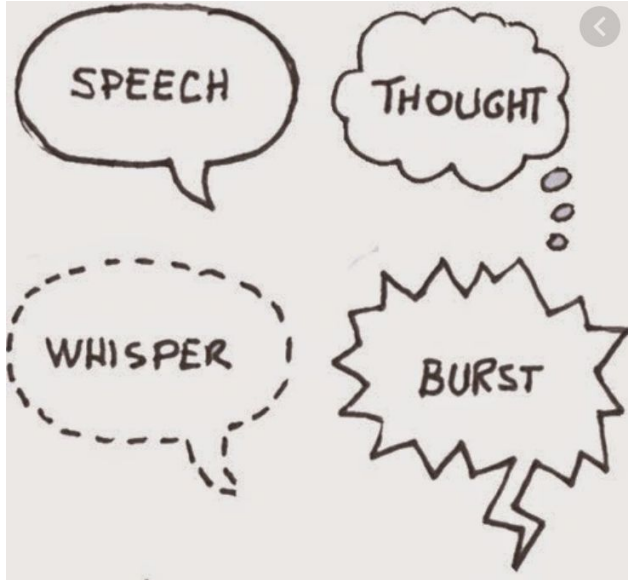
- You will need a main character (your hero). Think about their personality, what kind of things will your hero say?

Before you start drawing make sure you know who your characters are and what problem they are solving!

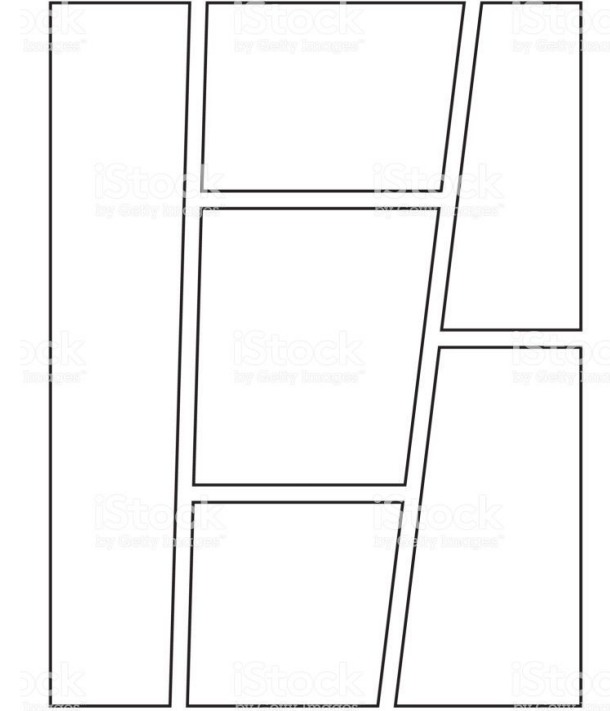
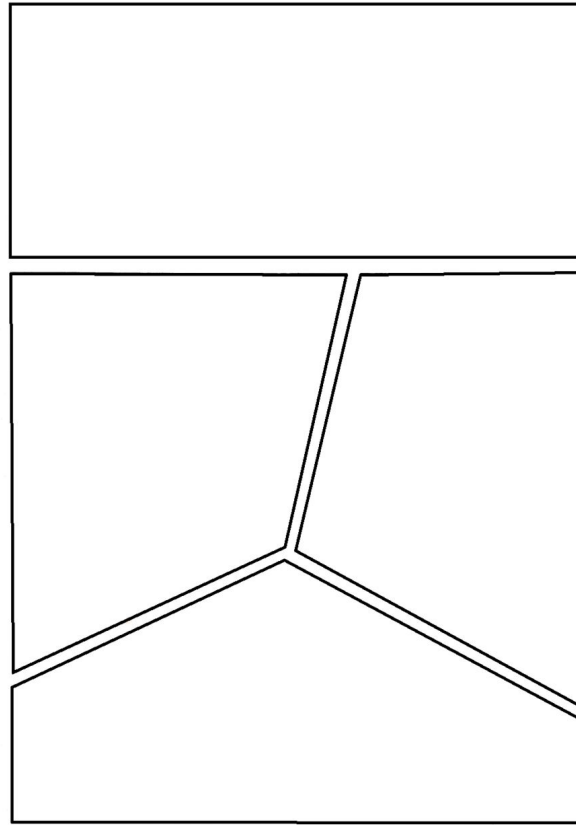
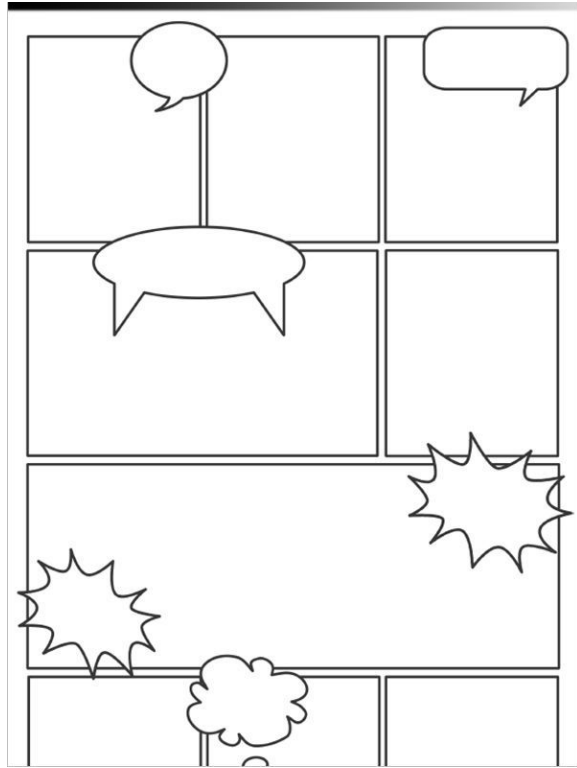
Include speech bubbles in your comic strip.
