I find addition and subtraction word problems tricky

I had 15 pencils. I gave 5 away. How many have I got left now?

I had 20 ducks. Daddy gave me 4 more. How many ducks have I got now?

I had 12 toy bats. Daddy gave me 3 more. How many toy bats have I got now?

We bought 10 cakes. I ate 7. How many cakes have I got left?

I had 27 books. Mummy took away 7. How many books have I got left now?

I got 8 presents at my party. Grandma gave me 6 more. How many presents have I got now?

I find addition and subtraction word problems ok

I had 15 pencils. I gave 5 away. How many have I got left now?

I had 12 toy bats. Daddy gave me 13 more. How many toy bats have I got now?

I had 27 books. Mummy took away 18. How many books have I got left now?

I had 39 ducks. Daddy gave me 27 more. How many ducks have I got now?

We bought 29 cakes. I ate 13. How many cakes have I got left?

I got 23 presents from friends. My family gave me 22 more. How many presents have I got now?

I would like a bit of a challenge today

I had 125 pencils. I gave 15 away. How many have I got left now?

I had 132 sweets. Daddy gave me 29 more. How many sweets have I got now?

I had 127 books. Mummy took away 11. How many books have I got left now?

I had 139 ducks. Daddy gave me 15 more. How many ducks have I got now?

We bought 29 cakes. I ate 7, then my sister ate 3. How many cakes have I got left?

I counted 41 birds. Daddy saw 12. Mummy saw 2 more. How many birds did we see altogether?
