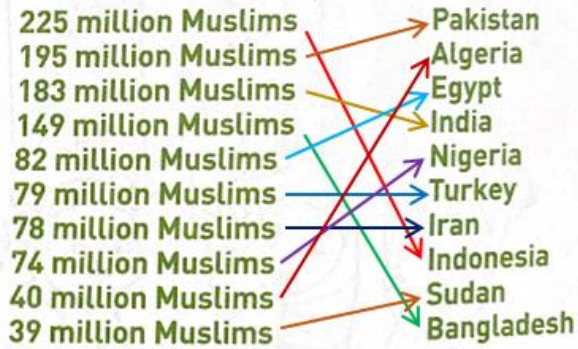


MUSLIMS OF THE WORLD

SALAH

Salah is the second pillar of Islam and this Arabic word means to pray. It is a way of worshipping Allah.

Muslims pray five times a day. The names of the prayers are called **Fajr, Dhuhr, Asr, Maghrib** and **Isha**.

SALAH TIMES

Here is a recap of the Salah times and what the sun is doing:

Fajr - early morning time - the sun is rising

Dhuhr - lunchtime - the sun has passed its highest point

Asr - late afternoon - the sun is not so high and is coming down slowly

Magrib - evening time - the sun has set

Isha - nighttime - the sun is out of sight
